



# Prop 39 Program Improvement Funds Fact Sheet

**Overview:** Program Improvement funds will be allocated to individual colleges to strengthen existing energy efficiency/clean energy programs. Funding is based on the number of 2013/2014 unduplicated energy efficiency/clean energy related student awards.

## Eligible Programs and Award Amounts:

---

Program Improvement fund awards range from \$500 - \$1,000. Awards are allocated to programs on a per-capita basis based on completers of energy efficiency related certificates, degrees, third party credentials and apprenticeships in the 2013/2014 school year (July 1, 2013 – June 30, 2014). One unduplicated award is allowed per student.

- Certificates 6 - 17 units - \$500 award per completer
- Certificates or degrees 18+ units - \$1,000 award per completer
- Apprenticeship completers (Journeyman level) - \$1,000 per completer
- Third party credentials - \$ 500 per completer

## Eligibility Requirements:

---

- Degrees and certificates must fall under the Chancellor's Office pre-approved TOP codes
- Colleges must provide explanation detailing how eligible programs fit Prop 39 definition of energy efficiency
- Third party credentials and apprenticeship programs require Chancellor's Office pre-approval
- Certificates must be listed in the Chancellor's MIS system
- Colleges are encouraged to register completers in the CalJOBS system
- Certificates, degrees, third party credentials and apprenticeships must be completed by end of 2014 school year
- Documentation of third party certification must be provided to Project Director in application

## Use of Program Improvement Funds:

---

- Funds shall be used to improve existing energy efficiency and clean energy programs
- Funds can support participating programs in the form of energy efficiency and clean energy related supplies and equipment, faculty professional development activities, and/or curriculum or professional development
- Funds will be allocated in October 2014
- Funds must be spent by March 31, 2015
- Recipients of Program Improvement funds will be required to submit one follow up expenditure report per program
