This two-hour training will introduce participants to the benefits of lighting controls. RadioRA2 is a completely retrofit system, which allows for energy savings in lighting, temperature, appliances and shades. Although it is mainly marketed to residential applications it is also utilized in commercial applications such as restaurants, bars and retail stores. The training will include a demonstration of the installation and programming of the system as well as its flexibility.
